Additional Information

Getting to the start, from Pleasure Island head along the access road into Thorpe Park, at the roundabout take the second exit, take the next right past the Entertainment Complex Entrance to the car park which is the start area.

Car Parking. Parking will be at the Pleasure Island main car park and must display a Ride4Life window sticker.

Registration, toilets, refreshments and certificate collection. In the Entertainment Complex.

Awards. Certificates will be awarded to all youngsters under the age of 16 who complete a minimum of one lap.

(one lap = 3 miles. Maximum laps to ride is four)

On completion of your ride register your achievements at the Ride4Life desk in the Entertainment Complex.

Safety:

1. All under 16 year olds must wear a cycle helmet. Failure to do so will result in not being able to take part in the ride.
2. It is not a race, the ride will be led by qualified British Cycling ride leaders. No overtaking of the leaders at any time.
3. Normal road and cycle laws will apply.
4. It is the responsibility of all riders to ensure that their bike is in a roadworthy condition. There will be no facilities for any repairs. *(suggest you carry a puncture repair kit, just in case)*
